## THE MINUTES OF THE BOARD OF EDUCATION OF GREENFIELD COMMUNITY UNIT SCHOOL DISTRICT NO. 10 April 25, 2022

The Board of Education of Greenfield Community Unit School District No. 10 met in regular session, in the Administrative Office, on April 25, 2022.

1. Board President Elliott Turpin called the regular meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. Upon roll call board members present were Chris Goode, Joe Kinser, Chris Weller, Brandi Rynders, Kate Garner and Elliott Turpin. Dr. Kevin Bowman, High School Principal Beth Bettis, Elementary Principal Jeremy Lansaw, Ron Plogger, Beth Burrow, Stephanie Vetter and several FFA members were also present.

2. Kinser motioned and Rynders seconded to approve the agenda as presented. Upon roll call Weller, Rynders, Goode, Kinser, Garner and Turpin voted "Aye". Motion carried.

Members participated in a FFA Trap Shoot and attended the National FFA convention. Three members were awarded the IL State FFA Degree and will walk across the stage at the IL FFA Convention this summer. The FFA farm is currently getting over 3 dozen eggs a day from their hens. They have 13 piglets and 3 bottle calves that have been donated. Country Financial sponsored the FFA to plant trees for Arbor Day. They were awarded \$500 community grant from Farm Credit to purchase new planters for the town square. Brandi Rynders applied and won a \$5000 Bayer Grant and donated this to the FFA.
